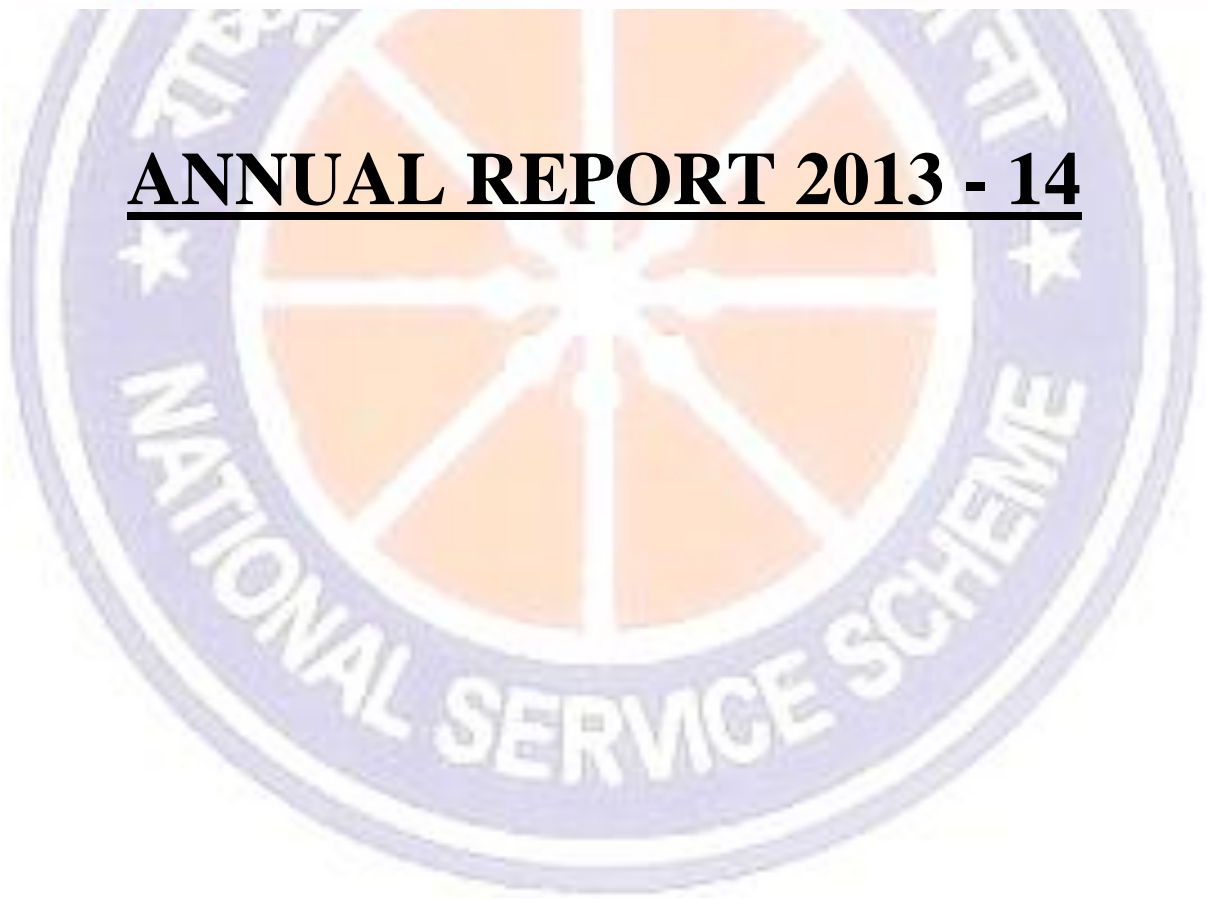

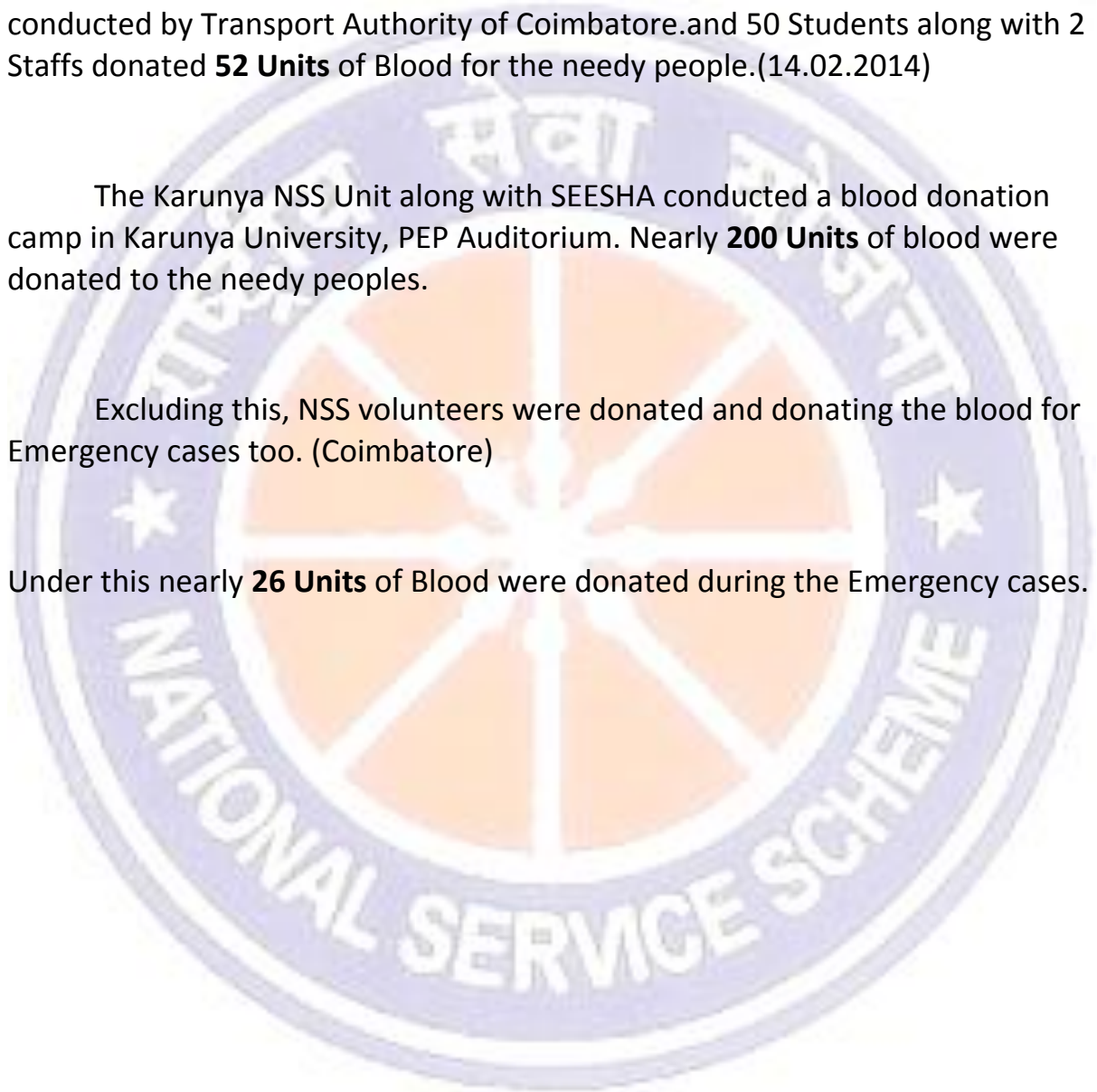
REPORT ON BLOOD DONATION CAMP:

1. ORIENTATION

13-07-2013

REPORT

On behalf of the NSS activity that took place on the Saturday [13/07/2013], as per the instruction given the following NSS activity has been done. New villages visit was conducted on that day.



MUGASIMANGALAM

A village named Mugasimangalam was visited and following service activity was done. A scope for a service has been reviewed and a consultation based on basic needs has been reviewed on account of it. Hence surveying was compiled. The Result was compiled for the future rectification of that problem.

The NSS members started their journey towards Boluvampati with a word of prayer on 13-07-2013.



After reaching the village NSS members were divided into groups and took survey to understand their grievance and needs. The main objective was to see if the drinking water facilities were adequate in the assigned area. The next concern of importance was given to sanitation.

Members were supposed to check whether all the houses have proper sanitation and there is no stagnation, inundation and the surrounding should be clean. Members were also asked to see if NSS could get to know any of their social problems or any of the facilities they lacked so that NSS could help them.



The event ended with a word of prayer.

NATHEGOUNDANPUDUR

The NSS members started their journey towards Nathegoundanpudhur with a word of prayer on 13-07-2013.

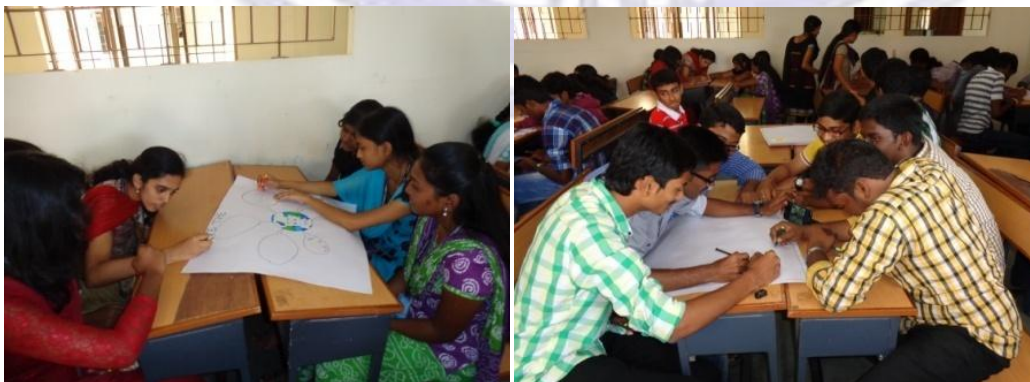
