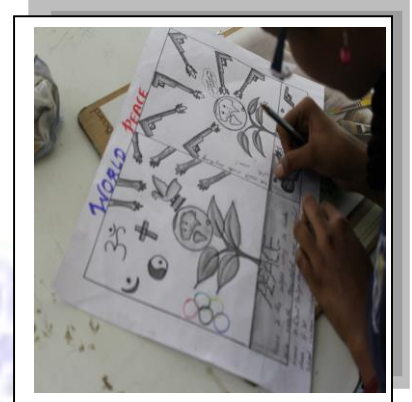
ACTIVITY: BLOOD DONATION CAMP**NO. OF VOLUNTEERS PARTICIPATED: 66**

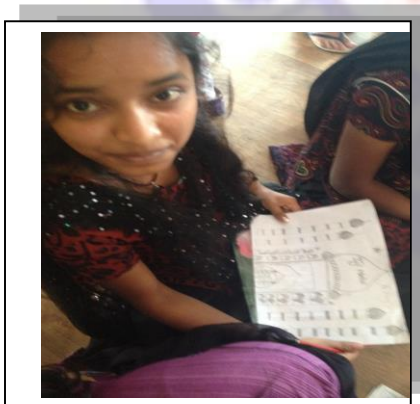


In the morning, boys cleaned the plastics in and around Mathuvarayapuram simultaneously computer literacy was also held for the village students by MCA girls coordinators.

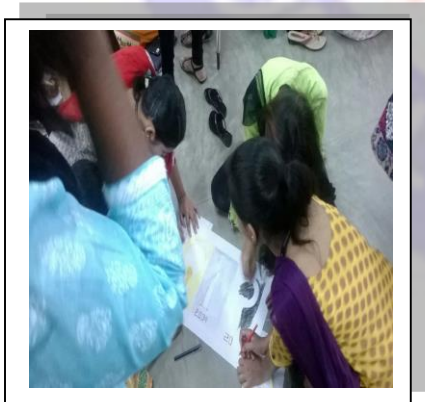


Students were made to watch videos that brings social awareness and were made to understand the theme of the MAD (We care we share).
